## **WORKPLACE HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY**

All aspects of work planning are given priority to ensure compliance with the statutory legislation covering workplace health and safety and the environment. To achieve this we will provide:

- Properly maintained plant and safe systems of work
- Adequate information, induction, instruction, training and supervision to enable work to be carried out safely and in accordance with health and safety rules
- PPE in accordance with Council requirements and regulations
- Support where required to establish suitable consultative programs
- Safe premises and workplaces, site facilities and layout, including access to and egress from them
- Safe working environments with adequate rehabilitation facilities
- Communication and advisory facilities as required, including consultation, cooperation and coordination with workers and other duty holders on site
- Design, recognition and application of safe working practices
- Effective management of health and safety incidents
- Innovative leadership contributing to accident-free work and a pollution free environment
- Pedestrian and site User Traffic Management requirements – demonstrating safe movement of pedestrians around the site, truck movements and staff parking
- Site risk assessment with control measures and Safe Work Method Statements for high risk work including but not limited to:

- Demolition of an element of a structure that is load-bearing or otherwise related to the physical integrity of the structure
- Work carried out on, in or adjacent to a road, railway, shipping lane or other traffic corridor that is in use by traffic other than pedestrians
- Work carried out in an area at a workplace in which there is any movement of powered mobile plant
- Work involving a risk of a person falling more than 2m (Working at Heights)
- Recordkeeping including forms/checklists used as main/head contractor for duration of project i.e. safety inspections.
